DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed Supervisor Plat No. 1 of the Northeast one-quarter (N. E. 1/4) of the South-west one-quarter (S. W. 1/4) of Section Thirteen (Sec. 13) Township Forty-seven (47) North, Range Forty-six (46) West, Bessemer Township, County Gogebic, State Michigan, is described as follows:—Commencing at the center of Section 13, thence S. 0-29' W. 131.3', thence S. 89-54' W. 490.54' thence N. 0-29' W. 30.14', thence N. 1/2 along Ely, bank of the Black River 697' more or less to a point which is S. 0-29' West 686.7', and due West 52.75' from place of beginning, thence N. 2-29' W. 143.29', thence due West 747.56', thence N. 0-29' E. 551.70', thence S. 89-49' E. 132.9' to place of beginning.

I hereby certify that the plat herewith delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments of not less than one inch in diameter and fifteen inches in length are in a concrete base at least four inches in diameter, and forty-eight inches by depth have been placed at points marked thereon as at thereon shown as all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, at all the intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, or of streets and alleys, and at the intersections of streets and alleys with the boundaries of the plat as shown on said plat.

Also that all monuments on block corners, and at the intersections of streets, intersections of alleys, or of streets and alleys, are set at the uniform distance of four feet from the adjacent block or lot lines. This was done to avoid of removing fences and buildings which were previously built on the premises.

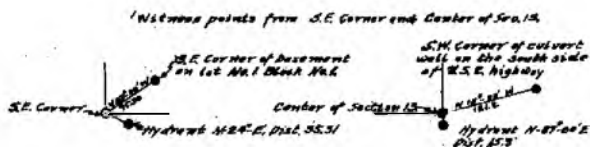

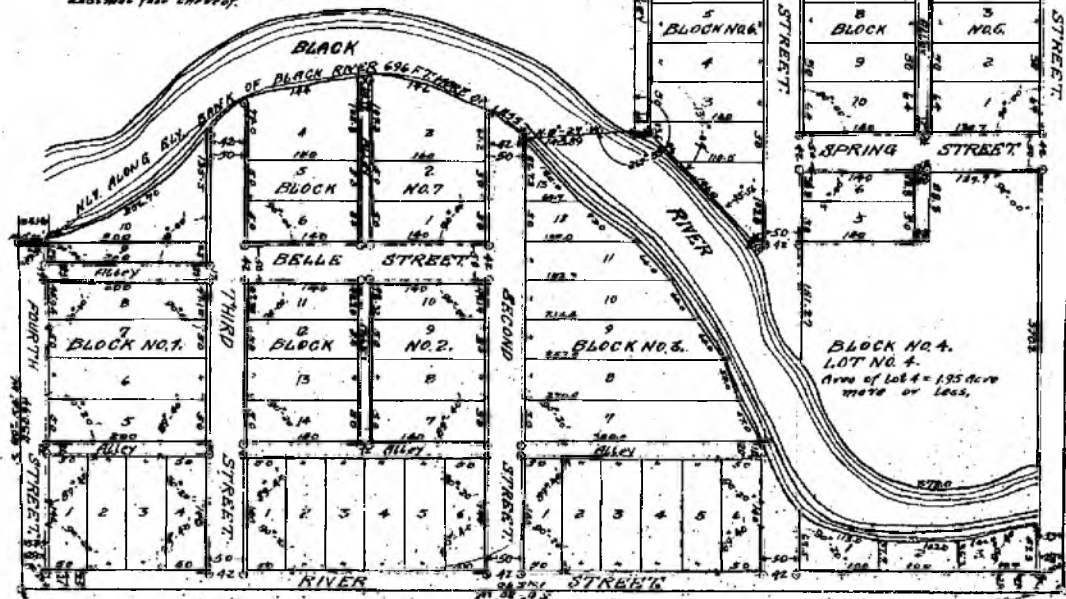
