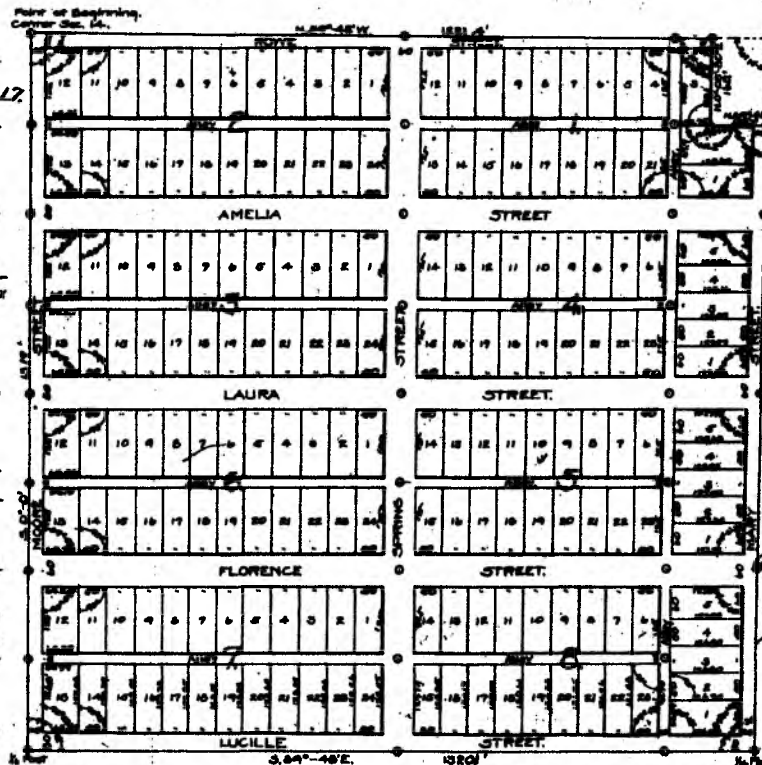


MAP

The land embraced in the annexed plat of the Village of Anvil is described as follows: - Being a portion of the Northwest one-quarter (N.W. 1/4) of the Southeast one-quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section Fourteen (14) Town Forty-Seven North (T.47N.) of Range Forty-six West (R.46W) Gogebic County, Mich. and more particularly described as follows: - Beginning at an iron pipe at the NW corner of said plat; thence the center of Sec. 14, T.47N.-R.46W. thence due South along the center line (assuming said center line to be due N. and S.) a distance of 1314 feet to an iron pipe, the 1/4 Post at the SW cor. thence S. 69° 45' E. 1380 ft. to an iron pipe, the 1/4 Post at the S.E. cor. thence N. 0° 05' 30" E. 113 1/2 ft. to an iron pipe, thence N. 69° 42' W. 100 ft. to an iron pipe, thence N. 0° 05' 30" E. 160 ft. to an iron pipe, thence N. 69° 42' W. 1221.4 ft. to the point of beginning.
